

ORDINANCE NO. 33

PARKING AND SNOW REMOVAL ORDINANCE

The Town Board for the Town of Geneva, Walworth County, Wisconsin, does ordain that the Town of Geneva Ordinance No. 33 is hereby repealed and that the following is hereby created.

Section 1.

No person shall park any vehicle within the right-of-way of any roadway within the municipal limits of the Town of Geneva between the hours of 2:00 o'clock a.m. and 12:00 o'clock Noon from November 15th of each year to March 31st of the succeeding year.

Section 2.

Any vehicle parked in violation of this Ordinance may be removed by the Township and the cost of removal and storage of said vehicle shall be chargeable to the record owner or authorized operator of said vehicle.

Section 3.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall forfeit not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, together with the costs of prosecution thereof, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution, shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding ten (10) days.

Section 4. Effective Date.

The repeal of the existing Ordinance and the passage of this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption by the Town Board and upon posting a publication thereof as provided by the Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.
