ORDINANCE NO. 24

FIREWORKS

Section 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person to store, sell, offer, or expose for sale, use, discharge, or cause to be discharged, ignited, or otherwise set into action within the Township of Geneva, any fireworks as described in Section 167.10 of the Wisconsin Statutes, except as provided in this Section.

Section 2.

Permits for public display of fireworks to be displayed by properly qualified individuals, patriotic organizations, or Township Officials, under the direct supervision of experts in the handling of fireworks, may be issued by the Town Chairman as provided in Section 167.10(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes upon furnishing such information as may be required by the Town Chairman as to the qualifications of the applicant.

Section 3.

The provisions of this Section shall not apply to articles of the kind and nature herein mentioned which shall be in the possession of transportation unless the same shall be held involuntarily by such railroads or companies as warehousemen. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to signaling devices used by the railroad companies or to explosives used for blasting or similar purposes.

Section 4.

Anyone violating the terms of this Ordinance shall forfeit not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars nor more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, together with the costs of prosecution thereof, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution, shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding sixty (60) days.
