## **ORDINANCE NO. 41**

## PROHIBITING ISSUANCE OF ALCOHOL BEVERAGE LICENSES FOR NONPAYMENT OF TAXES, ASSESSMENTS, AND CLAIMS

The Town Board of the Town of Geneva, Walworth County, Wisconsin, does ordain Town of Geneva Ordinance No. 41 as follows:

Section 1. License Restrictions.

- A. Delinquent Taxes, Assessments, and Claims.
  - 1. Premises. No initial or renewal alcohol beverage license shall be granted for any premises for which taxes, assessments, or other claims of the Town are delinquent and unpaid.
  - 2. Persons. No initial or renewal alcohol beverage license shall be granted to any person:
    - (a) Delinquent in payment of taxes, assessments, or other claims owed to the Town.
    - (b) Delinquent in payment of a forfeiture resulting from a violation of any ordinance of the Town.
    - (c) Delinquent in payment to the State of any State taxes owed.
- Section 2. <u>Effective Date.</u>

This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its adoption by the Town Board and its posting or publication as provided by the Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.
