## ORDINANCE NO. 60

## AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THE NUMBER AND SHIFTS OF ELECTION INSPECTORS IN THE TOWN OF GENEVA WALWORTH COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Geneva, Walworth County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

## Section 1.

- A. NUMBER. There shall be not more than seven nor less than three election inspectors per shift at each polling place where elections are conducted.
- B. APPOINTMENT. Appointment of inspectors shall be in the manner provided by Wisconsin law.
- $\,$  C. TIME. There shall be two shifts of inspectors scheduled at such times as the Town Clerk deems appropriate.
- D. STAFFING. The Town Clerk shall determine in advance of each election the number of inspectors to be scheduled for each shift, which determination shall depend on the number of contests on the ballot, the degree of interest in the election, and the apparent likelihood of a large percentage of voter participation.
- Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
