

ORDINANCE NO. 75.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT REFERENDUM FOR TOWN CAPITAL EXPENDITURES OF  
\$1,000,000 OR MORE

The Town Board of the Town of Geneva, Walworth County, Wisconsin, does  
ordain Town of Geneva Ordinance No. 75 as follows:

Section 1. Referendum: Prior to the start of any physical construction of any  
Town financed (in whole or in part) project requiring a Town capital expenditure which  
aggregates \$1,000,000 or more, the Town Board shall submit to the electorate a binding  
referendum for approval of the project. The wording of any referendum shall provide  
the specific purpose, location and costs of the project. Nothing in this provision shall be  
construed to preclude the Town from exercising its role in the planning or design of such  
publicly financed projects. The Town shall be precluded from intentionally dividing up a  
project so that the total amount is less than \$1,000,000.

Section 2. Effective Date

The passage of this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption  
by the Town Board and its posting or publication thereof as required, pursuant to s. 60.80,  
Wis. Stat.
