## Section 19: Inspection of Premises; Right of Access

- A. During reasonable hours, any officer or authorized employee of the District shall have the right of access to the premises supplied with service for the purpose of inspecting, examining, repairing, installing or removing the meters, pipes, fittings, wires and works for supplying or regulating the supply of water and for the purpose of ascertaining the quantity of water supplied or for the enforcement of the District's rules and regulations.
- B. No officer or authorized employee of the District may enter any premises under this section unless the officer or employee:
  - 1. Has been duly appointed by the District for the purpose of acting under this section.
  - 2. Exhibits written authority signed by the president of the District.
- C. Any officer or authorized employee of the District shall have the right of access to the premises supplied with service upon 30 days written notice for purposes of removing and replacing any water meter in conjunction with a District meter testing and maintenance program pursuant to Wisconsin Administrative Code Section PSC 185.76.
