ORDINANCE NO. 60

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THE NUMBER AND SHIFTS OF ELECTION INSPECTORS IN THE TOWN OF GENEVA WALWORTH COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town Board for the Town of Geneva, Walworth County, Wisconsin, does ordain that the Town of Geneva Ordinance No. 60 is hereby amended and restated as follows:

Section 1.

- A. NUMBER. The number of election inspectors per polling place shall be as provided by WI stats. 7.30. Per WI stats. 7.32 no such action shall reduce the number of officials at a polling place to less than three.
- B. APPOINTMENT. Appointment of inspectors shall be in the manner provided by Wisconsin law.
- C. TIME. There shall be two shifts of inspectors scheduled at such times as the Town Clerk deems appropriate.
- D. STAFFING. The Town Clerk shall determine in advance of each election the number of inspectors to be scheduled for each shift, which determination shall depend on the number of contests on the ballot, the degree of interest in the election, and the apparent likelihood of a large percentage of voter participation.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
