ORDINANCE NO. 62

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT FEEDING OF WATERFOWL & GULLS IN THE TOWN OF GENEVA WALWORTH COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Geneva, Walworth County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Prohibition.

No person shall feed or participate in feeding any waterfowl or gulls on any property owned by the Town or on any private property or parks which are posted with a sign prohibiting the same.

Section 2. Sign.

Any sign prohibiting the feeding of waterfowl or gulls posted on private property or parks shall be:

- (i) At least 11" square in size;
- (ii) Posted in not less than two (2) places for each 40 acres or fraction thereof; and
- (iii) Reference Town Ordinance No. 62.

Section 3. Penalties.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance may be required, upon conviction thereof, to forfeit not less than Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) Dollars, together with the costs of prosecution.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
